Subject: Legislature; registration of lobbyists; badges

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require all lobbyists, while in the state house, to wear badges that identify the lobbyist and all of the lobbyist's employers.

An act relating to requiring lobbyists to wear badges in the state house

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 2 V.S.A. § 269 is added to read:

§ 269. LOBBYISTS IN THE STATE HOUSE; BADGES

While in the state house, a lobbyist shall wear a badge that identifies the lobbyist and all of the employers of the lobbyist.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
