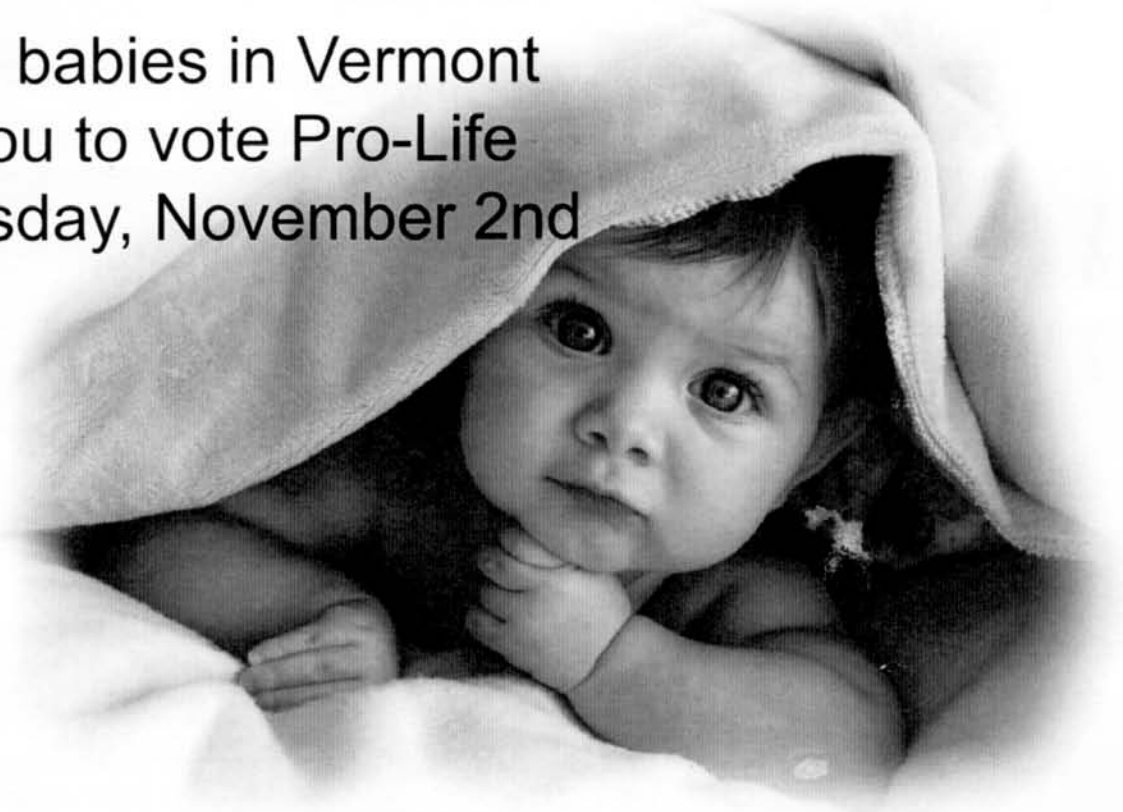

Compare the candidates for Governor

Brian Dubie has stated:

"I have been very clear with my belief on abortion. I'm pro life. I can't change who I am. I won't change who I am." (Burlington Free Press 9/23/10)

"I am pro-life. I stand on my record. I will continue to support pro-adoption efforts ... I would continue to find common sense, common ground legislation like the Baby Safe Haven Bill which I testified for in the Senate Judiciary Committee." (Vermont Woman Sept/Oct 2010)

Peter Shumlin supports unrestricted abortion throughout the entire nine months of a woman's pregnancy, including the gruesome late-term partial-birth abortion procedure. He also supports taxpayer funding of every abortion and opposes parental involvement laws. He has vowed, if elected, to pass a physician-assisted suicide bill in 2011.

Peter Shumlin:

- Voted to allow state funding of partial-birth abortions.
- Sponsored bills to legalize physician-assisted suicide.
- Supports the pro- abortion lobby 100%.

Phil Scott has on his website, that while he is "pro-choice":
